**Born in Belfast, Ireland** in 1898. Died 1963. Fought in Somne, France in WWI Became professor at Magdalen College, **Oxford** Atheist until 1929, then Christian in 1931.

(Lewis' Surprised by Joy is the story of coming to know Jesus Christ.) Member of "Inklings" — Writers like JRR Tolkien and Charles Williams **Wrote Chronicles of** Narnia starting in 1950

Based on his hosting of 3 evacuee children during WWII. For his god-daughter, Lucy.
